



CANBERRA REQUIREMENTS

Dear Parents/Carers,

Below is some information that we hope will assist you when getting your child ready for the upcoming Canberra excursion on Wednesday 26, 27 and 28 April 2023.

All students **MUST** be at school on Wednesday 26 April no later than **5:45am**. **The bus will be departing at 6:00am and will not wait for late arrivals.** Students are to go to the school hall on arrival to get their name marked off and hand in any medication.

Clothing and toiletries

- Pyjamas
- A pair of jeans, track pants or similar warm long pants
- A pair of shorts
- Three t-shirts (long and short sleeved)
- A jumper or jacket
- A warm Jacket
- Enough underwear and socks for 3 days.
- Closed-in shoes – Runners/walking shoes. **No open-toed shoes allowed.**
- Toiletries, including toothpaste, toothbrush, comb or brush and something for lips to prevent chapping (lip balm or Vaseline)
- No make-up or jewellery please.
- Money at parent's discretion to purchase items from Questacon. Children will be responsible for their own money.
- A large plastic bag for dirty / wet clothes.

School Uniform – Thursday only

- On Thursday we will be visiting Parliament House. It is a requirement that all students wear full school uniform with black shoes for this activity. Please ensure your child's uniform is packed in their luggage.

Requirements for the Wednesday 26 April (1st day).

- Students are to wear sensible muffti clothing. **Also, a packed morning tea and lunch is required for day one.** Sandwiches, health bars, fruit and poppers/ plastic water bottles are best for travelling. These should be packed in a disposable bag and kept in a travel bag on the coach. There will be no opportunities to buy food.

Medical information:

- If your child suffers from travel sickness, please administer suitable medication before departure and supply your child with further medication for the next three days.
- All medication **MUST** be given to a teacher and be labelled with the following information:
 - Medication name
 - Student's name
 - Dosage
 - Time to be given
- ALL MEDICATION SHOULD BE CLEARLY LABELLED WITH NAME AND FULL INSTRUCTIONS FOR ADMINISTRATION AND HANDED TO TEACHERS BEFORE GETTING ON THE BUS. ASTHMA MANAGEMENT PLANS NEED TO BE UP TO DATE.
- Students are required to carry their own **Ventolin puffer** and be able to administer when required.

NOTE:

- A camera may be taken; however, it will be the child's responsibility.
- One bag for storage under the coach, containing clothes, toiletries etc.
- One small bag to be kept on the coach, containing lip balm, asthma puffers, water bottle and recess/ lunch and afternoon tea for the first day.
- **Mobile Phones are NOT permitted.**
