
Ants are amazing insects! There are thousands of different species of ants. They can be found all over the world, except in Antarctica.

# Fascinating Facts About Minibeasis



Bees are the only insects in the world to make honey that people can easily harvest and sell. One bee makes about one-twelfth of a teaspoon of honey in its entire life. 2
