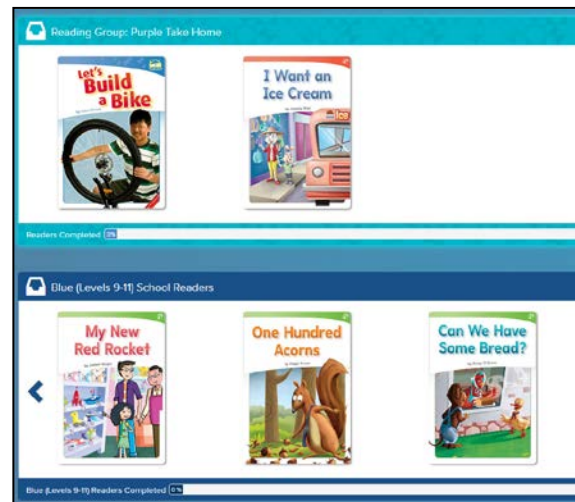


Our school has recently started using Wushka, an Australian online Reading Program.

Wushka not a game-based program. Instead, it has been created from traditional Readers and also has all of the benefits of a digital program – it captures data and statistics on children’s reading history, and is easily accessible 24/7.

When your child logs in, they will be taken to their Homepage. There may be a Reading Group section at the top of this page, which your child’s teacher will have created specifically for your child. The Readers in this Box will likely be the priority for home reading, but your child may also have access to other Readers in their reading level. This will be at the discretion of your child’s teacher.



You will notice that Wushka’s Readers are narrated, but whether this feature is turned on or off will be up to your child’s teacher.

Your child may be required to do a comprehension quiz at the end of the Reader. Once your child has completed the Reader and the quiz, they can go to their My Page where a graph of their reading progress is constantly updated. They can also go to their Online Quiz Results page to see how they have been going in their quizzes.

Children can favourite Readers and access them from their My Page and their Favourites page. This helps to encourage a love of reading, as children can re-read Readers that they have enjoyed.
