Preschool Information evening

The Preschool information session will take place this evening for families of children enrolling in 2017. We have 40 places filled in our Preschool on a 5 day fortnight rotational basis for 2017. Our Preschool operates under the guidelines of the Early Years Learning Framework and follows the seven key Quality Areas of the National Quality Standard for all Early Childhood centres.
