Three-way Conferences (Years 1 to 6) and Parent-Teacher Interviews (Kindergarten)

Dear Parents/Carers,

Interviews to discuss student progress will be conducted during Weeks 3 and 4 of this term. Given the fact that the NSW Department of Education COVID-19 guidelines stipulate that parents are not allowed onsite at present, interviews will be conducted using the 'Zoom' video-conferencing platform, or by telephone. Parents may opt to participate in a 'Three-way Conference', with students sharing in the discussion of their achievements, and in such instances it is expected that the conferences will be conducted using 'Zoom' to allow for the necessary interaction between all participants. Alternatively, parents can opt to speak with their child's teacher over the telephone, without their child being present.

As indicated last week on social media platforms, the window for booking interviews opened this morning at 10:00am, and will extend to 12pm on Thursday 30th July.
